The Opportunity

We are looking for a theologically trained, suitably qualified Pastor to join our ministry team here at The Bridge Church in the lower North Shore of Sydney as our Neutral Bay site Director for Children's Ministry.

We would welcome applicants with a broad experience base for this exciting role, which will include responsibility for Children's ministry on Sundays and throughout the week at our Neutral Bay location. This role will be part-time, working 4 days per week.

A stipend will be in accordance with the diocesan remuneration guidelines, based on experience and qualifications. This role will report to the Children's and Family Pastor.
